#### Tournament's Format: Four- Ball (Better-Ball)

The term "Four Ball" applies to a Stroke Play competition. When played as Stroke Play, Four-Ball sides consist of two golfers per team. In the Stroke Play version, each side is playing against the field. On the first hole, Player A and Player B score 5 and 4, respectively, so the team's score is 4. Continue in that fashion marking down the team's score on each hole, and adding up the total at the end for the 18-hole team score. Stroke Play Four-Ball is probably more commonly called some variation of 2-person Best-Ball in club and association tournaments. Handicaps are applied to each player's score for this event at 90% (Men) & 95% (Ladies) – using USGA handicapping guidelines.



#### **Tie-Breaking Methods**

A sudden death playoff will determine gross champions only in each flight. All other ties (net champions and gross and net runners-up will be determined using a USGA recommendation for breaking ties. USGA (last 9, then 6, 3, 1, holes): This perhaps is the most popular tie-breaking method that the USGA recommends. If two players tie with scores of 78, their last 9 scores will count as the tie breaker. If these two players both shoot a 40 on the last 9, we will move onto the last 6, 3, and 1 hole(s) until we find a winner. If there still is no winner, then there will be a tie.

## LOCAL RULES OF PLAY

All play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and its Decisions and the following local rules that apply to this golf course:

- 1. PREFERRED LIES: Players are allowed to lift, clean, and place their ball within 12 inches in their own fairway all weekend.
- 2. DROP AREAS: Drop areas are defined by painted white circles and are located on hole #5 (along bunker)
- 3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Defined by connected white lines, white flags, or blue stakes. All decorative flowerbeds and landscaped mulch areas around trees shall be considered Ground Under Repair and relief is mandatory.
- 4. STONEWALLS: Stonewalls are deemed to be integral parts of the course. No free relief.
- 5. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: In this competition, a player may obtain distance information only by using a device that measures distance only. Cell phones and their proper applications are included in this local rule.
- 6. PACE OF PLAY POLICY: Teams must complete today's round in no more than four hours and forty-five minutes (4:45). Teams not finishing in this time frame will be penalized.
