2024 TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

- ✓ Players who sign-up for any club tournament automatically agree to the tournament's rules and regulations.
- ✓ All players must have a valid handicap to participate in tournaments.
- ✓ Club tournaments are open to all member classifications. Breakfast Club members are not eligible to participate in any member event unless it's a guest during the Fall Invitational. Men's and Ladies' League players are allowed to participate in Fall Invitational as members.
- ✓ See individual tournament descriptions for registration dates, deadlines, and posting information.
- ✓ Requests for early or late starting times and pairings will be honored when possible. This request, though, is never guaranteed.
- ✓ Entry fees and player eligibility are listed with each tournament description.
- ✓ Payment is requested by the tournament's entry closing date. Participants will not be allowed to play if payment has not been obtained.
- ✓ All tournaments are co-ed. Ladies' divisions will be formed when possible.
- ✓ A \$20 fee will be charged to those players who withdraw from at 72-hours prior to event's start.
- ✓ Play will be governed by the latest edition of the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA, the USGA Handicapping Manual, and any rules addendums handed out by the Club. Rules disputes are to be settled by the tournament director (usually the director of golf) in charge of the competition and the tournament director's decision shall be final. Competition shall be deemed to have closed when the results have been officially announced.
- ✓ Any player whose actions during any Breakfast Hill Golf Club tournament are deemed by the Club to be detrimental to the host club or to the tournament will be subject to penalties as determined by the Club, such possible penalties to include removal from the tournament, and suspension from future Breakfast Hill Golf Club events for a period to be determined by the Director of Golf.
- ✓ Any player who "no shows" for play without notifying the tournament director prior to their starting time or who walks off the course during play other than for injury or emergency reasons will be subject to the following penalty: BREAKFAST HILL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WITHHOLD THE ENTRY FOR ANY OR ALL CLUB EVENTS FOR ONE YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. Anyone who wishes to withdraw during the championship MUST notify the Director of Golf. No refunds will be issued for these reasons.
- ✓ Trophies and/or merchandise credit will be awarded to tournament champions and/or runners-up. All credit must be redeemed by Golf Shop closure for the season, or it will be forfeited. There are no exceptions to this rule.
- ✓ Pace of play: In addition to any Pace of Play guidelines set forth by the director of golf (director), the following provision will be in force at this event: Note: The Director reserves the right, at any time, to time a group when the Director deems it necessary. Further, if a player is determined by the Director to be unreasonably slow, he may be timed individually at the Director's discretion, regardless of whether his group is out of position. Players should also be aware that the Director may assess a "bad time" to a player in a group that is out of position if the player makes no effort to help his group to get back into position. Examples of this would be a player who unduly delays play between strokes or holes. Penalty: 1st Bad Time=Warning; 2nd Bad Time=1 stroke penalty; 3rd Bad Time=2 stoke penalty/loss of hole; 4th Bad Time=Disqualification.
- ✓ All club tournament dates, prices, formats, etc., are subject to change.

	(gross or net).
Handicaps	No strokes will be assigned for gross competition. 100% of each
	player's Course Handicap from the appropriate tee markers will
	be assigned for net play.
Pairings	The professional golf staff will assign tee times and pairing
	groups for first round play. Second round pairings will be
	determined based on Saturday's first round scores.
Tee markers & flights	Players will have the option to compete in one of four flights
	including: Championship Flight (all play to take place from the
	maroon markers); Men's Flight (all play to take place from the
	black markers); Senior Championship (all play to take place from
	the silver markers and all players must be 65+ years of age); and
	Ladies' Championship (all ladies to play from the gold markers).
Entry fee	\$60 for the entire event. Fee includes golf, cart (optional), range
	balls, and prizes.
Skins game	No skins game will be offered with this event.
