WEATHER WARNING POLICY

It is Breakfast Hill's policy will be to determine if inclement weather will cause the cancellation of a weekly league by 1:00 pm on the scheduled league day. The club will send email blasts to the field and our website (BreakfastHill.com) will have the most up-to-the-minute weather decision. If league has commenced, weather-warning signals will sound. When warning signals sound, everyone is advised to take proper precautions and return to the clubhouse immediately.

Discontinue and Resume Play Signal: One prolonged blast of siren, repeated. Avoid the following areas: Open areas, isolated greens, and golf carts.

2026 ENTRY FEES

Full, Weekday, and Afternoon Members.....\$250 (handicap included with membership)
Public Players.....\$495 (handicap included with enrollment)
Breakfast Club.....\$250 + Breakfast Club (choice of either \$470 for Weekday Club or \$600 for Daily Club). Breakfast Club card will have seven punches removed (covers greens fees; 13 punches remain each worth nine-holes). Depending on Club option, total league fee would be \$720 (with Weekday Club) or \$850 (with Daily Club)
GHIN fees are not included in the Breakfast Club league option. GHIN is a required and additional fee.

League fees include the following: Pre-league set-up and weekly registration; all league implementation and organization; golf carts (included but optional); pre-league announcements; league greens fees; professional scoring and skins tabulation immediately following play; weekly website updates and releases; weekly on-course contests and prizes; score posting in the handicap system every other week; end-of-season dinner and prizes; and weekly range balls.

PAYMENT IS DUE IN FULL BY DRAFT NIGHT ON WEDNESDAY, MAY 6, 2026

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

Registration.....Sunday, March 1 at 9:00 am for 2026 Members & returning league players from 2025; April 1 for general-public if spots remain.
Payment.....Deadline to pay all league entry dues is MAY 6, 2026
Draft Nights.....Spring Session Draft to take place on MAY 6; Summer Session Draft on JUNE 24 following play.
First Night of Play.....First half begins MAY 13; second half begins on JULY 8.
Idle.....JULY 1 (Have a safe and happy Independence Day holiday!).
Final Night of Play.....First half ends on JUNE 24; second half ends on AUGUST 19.
Awards & Dinner.....First half prizes will be posted and issued by JULY 1 (no dinner following first half); second half prizes will be posted by AUGUST 21 (dinner to follow August 19 play).

REGISTRATION PROCESS TO TAKE PLACE IN PHASES; FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS

Registration for the 2026 league field will begin on March 1, 2026 at 9:00 am via an online registration only. Phone calls to the Golf Shop do not guarantee acceptance into league. All 2026 Breakfast Hill members and returning players in “good standing” from 2025 will have until March 31, 2026, to register. Starting April 1, 2026 (should spots remain), public players may register and players not in “good standing” may re-apply. Payment is due in-full on or before the League Draft night on Wednesday, May 6, 2026. Those who do not pay by this deadline may be subject to forfeiting their league roster spot.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2026 Breakfast Hill Golf Club Men's Twilight League is played on Wednesday evenings from May 13 to August 19. There is no league play on July 1 in observance of the Independence holiday. Weekly play will begin at 4:30 pm (shotgun start). Play will consist of 14-weeks of play split into two independent halves (spring and summer sessions). Formats will consist of team and individual formats.

PLAYER ENROLLMENT, FIELD SIZE

Breakfast Hill Golf Club's Men's League is very popular. Its field size has increased over the years from 64 to 112 players. During the initial registration on March 1, 2025, the field will be limited to 96 players. If demand warrants, the field size will increase in increments of eight (8) players with a maximum player count of 112 players. The Club always recommends interested players add their name to the league wait list as field size and/or substitutes may be needed throughout the season.

TEAMS TO BE FORMED DURING TWO DRAFT NIGHTS

FIRST HALF DRAFT (May 6 at 5:30 pm): A players will draft their B teammate (first round). C players will draft their D teammate (second round). The first and second round order selection will be made by drawing names at random out of a hat. A brief five-minute trade period will take place following the draft.

SECOND HALF DRAFT (June 24 following play; play begins at 4:30 pm): B players will draft their A teammate (first round). D players will draft their C teammate (second round). The first and second round order selection will be made by drawing names at random out of a hat. A brief five-minute trade period will take place following the draft.

LEAGUE DIVIDED INTO TWO SEPARATE FLIGHTS

At the beginning (April 29) and at the halfway point of the season (June 17) the league field will be divided into four divisions based on each player's GHIN index (A, B, C, D). At each Draft, the field will be separated into an “AB” flight and into a “CD” flight. “AB” players will not compete with “CD” at any point during the season.

SEASON RESETS AT MIDWAY POINT

To be fair to all players, the league will be split into two independent halves. After the spring session (May 13 to June 24), teams will be re-drafted, and the standings will re-set for the summer session (July 8 to August 19). In essence, all players are signing-up for two separate leagues throughout the season.

REMINDER FOR 2026! LOCAL RULE – ONE STROKE PENALTY AND DROP FOR OUT-OF-BOUNDS OR LOST BALL

In the event of hitting a ball out-of-bounds or a lost ball, players are allowed to drop their new ball either at point of entry (out-of-bounds) or in the vicinity of the lost ball. Players will incur a one-stroke penalty under these circumstances. This is a local rule for league only. This rule does not carry over to any other tournaments unless otherwise posted.

NEW IN 2026! TEE MARKERS PLAYED

Upon registration for the season, players will be asked their age. Location or “play from” tee markers will be determined by age. Men age 64 and under with a handicap index of 11.9 and under will play from the Maroon/Black markers. Men age 64 and under with a handicap index 12.0 and over will play from the Black markers. Men age 65 to 69 will compete from the Black/Silver markers. Senior men age 70 and over will battle from the Silver markers.

NEW IN 2026! SCORING ON GOLF GENIUS APP TO REPLACE PHYSICAL SCORECARDS

Your mobile device will be replacing physical scorecards for the 2026 league season. Live results can be viewed during and following play on the league portal or displayed in the Clubhouse (subject to change). Each foursome will receive a GGID (Golf Genius ID). This ID will allow for scoring by either one player in your playing foursome or by all players in your foursome. GGIDs will be displayed on cart steering wheels and posted on the scoreboard prior to play.

RANGE BALLS

Range balls are included in your Men's League fees. Range balls will be placed on the tee surface no earlier than 3:00 pm on the evening of league. Requests for balls prior to this time are subject to paying the full range ball price. Please respect all players and allow everyone a chance to warm-up. Do not spend extended periods of time warming up on the practice range.

WEEKLY PAIRINGS

Weekly pairing groups will be posted online by accessing the league portals online at BreakfastHill.com.

INDIVIDUAL FORMAT

Individual nine-hole matches vs. a different opponent within the same flight will take place every week throughout the season. Points are awarded for winning or halving matches. Points for winning or halving a match will increase as season progresses. See ascending point values below for more information. Prizes will be distributed to the top five players in each flight at each half's conclusion (prizes subject to change). Individual play resets halfway through the season. Individual results do not factor into team point totals.

TEAM FORMAT

Two-man teams will compete throughout the season. AB players will play on one nine while the CD players will play on the opposite nine. The format will consist of four-ball (better-ball) matches. AB teams will compete against other AB teams throughout the season (same with CD teams vs. CD teams). Points are awarded for winning or halving matches. Points for winning or halving a match will increase as season progresses. See below for more. Prizes will be distributed to the top five teams in each flight at each half's conclusion (prizes subject to change). Team play resets halfway through the season. Individual results do not factor into team point totals.

POINT STRUCTURE FOR WINNING, HALVING, AND LOSING MATCHES

The following point structures will be used for team and individual matches throughout the season:

Weeks 1, 2, and 3 = 1 points for win, ½ point for a halve, and no points for a loss
Weeks 4 and 5 = 2 points for win, 1 point for halve, and no points for loss
Weeks 6 and 7 = 3 points for win, 1 point for a halve, and no points a loss
Weeks 8, 9, and 10 = 1 points for win, ½ point for a halve, and no points for a loss
Weeks 11 and 12 = 2 points for win, 1 point for halve, and no points for loss
Weeks 13 and 14 = 3 points for win, 1 point for a halve, and no points a loss

SUBSTITUTES ALLOWED; NO MAKE-UPS FOR MISSED WEEKS, THOUGH

Breakfast Hill Golf Club does not allow participants to make-up or reschedule any missed league rounds. Substitutes are allowed but it is the responsibility of the player to find his substitute. The golf staff will assist if necessary. The handicap of the player substituting must be within four strokes of the absent player. Substitute points will only be awarded to team results. The substitute's won or halved points will NOT count to any individual standings. In team competition, the teammate who is present will be forced to compete by himself against the opposing team UNLESS you can find a substitute on a given week. Substitutes will be allowed for all play, and they must have GHIN handicap. All substitute's points will be applied to the absent player's team standings only. They are not eligible to substitute for individual points. The only prize a substitute can win are cash skins and/or Closest to the Pin prizes. Substitutes are not eligible for season-long prizes. Medical leave may be granted and requires the injured player to miss a minimum of three weeks.

HANDICAPS – ALL HANDICAPS ADJUSTED TO 80% FROM APPROPRIATE TEE MARKERS

Because this is a "team centric" league, weekly scorecards will be dotted off the low handicap in the foursome. Please keep in mind scorecards are dotted for four-ball matches only. All handicaps are adjusted to 80% from the appropriate tee markers. This handicapping policy is a league "local rule". Individual matches will be dotted off the low player in that match, but dots are NOT illustrated on the scorecard. Skins use each player's total nine-hole Course Handicap (off the course). Scorecards will be assigned to the appropriate carts prior to play. It is each player's responsibility to check each scorecard before returning it for scoring. Once the scorecards are turned in, the results will be deemed FINAL. Results WILL NOT be reviewed under any circumstance following each league night (unless it is to dispute data entry by the director of golf and/or golf staff).

HANDICAPPING INTEGRITY RELIES ON PROPERLY POSTING SCORES

The professional golf staff will post all scores to GHIN following league play. Handicaps will be adjusted prior to each week of competition.

NO STROKES TO BE ASSIGNED ON PAR 3'S

No strokes will be assigned on any par three throughout the league season. This includes for individual, team, and skins play.

SPECIAL WEEKLY CONTESTS

Men's League will offer weekly Closest to the Pin contests. One contest will be placed on the front nine; another will be placed on the back nine. A \$20 Golf Shop credit will be awarded to each winner on a weekly basis. There is no additional weekly fee to enter these special contests. Closest to the Pin contests are included in your league fee.

UPDATED FOR 2026 OPTIONAL TEAM SKINS GAME OFFERED EVERY WEEK

An optional team skins game will be offered during each week of the league season for an entry fee of \$10 per player. This fee includes entry into both gross and net skins contests. Cash prize will be awarded to teams who record the lowest gross and net score(s) on a given hole during their nine-hole round. Skins winners will be announced following play on every league night. If a skin is not won during a specific night the total pot will carry over to the following week. Players cannot "cut" their teammate's skins. **If a teammate does not enter the skins game but earns a skin, that player will not be entitled to their share of the skin total. Only the player who entered the game will earn their half. The unearned half of the skin will go "to the house".** All unclaimed skins money will be forfeited on September 15, 2026.

OPTIONAL HOLE-IN-ONE INSURANCE ACCEPTED THROUGHOUT THE SEASON

An optional \$5 hole-in-one insurance pool will be collected in the Golf Shop starting on week 1 of play. If a player records an "ace", the pool will reset and players must enter their fee again. At season's end, any remaining hole-in-one pool money will be donated to the restaurant and bar staff for their efforts throughout the season.

CANCELLATION IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather weekly play will be cancelled and not rescheduled. Greens and cart fees from these cancelled weeks will be re-allocated into the prize pool. Regardless of cancellations, all official play will conclude on Wednesday, August 19, 2026. The end-of-season awards dinner will take place following play on Wednesday, August 19, 2026. If the final week of play is cancelled due to weather, the league dinner finale will take place at 5:30 pm.

WEEKLY STANDINGS, RELEASES AND UPDATES AVAILABLE ONLINE AT BREAKFASTHILL.COM

All information regarding Men's League can be found throughout the season on the club's official website BreakfastHill.com. Once logging onto the home page click on "The Course" located at the top menu. From there go to the section called "League News". Weekly pairings and starting hole assignments will be posted on the Tuesday prior to play. Updated individual and team standings will be posted as soon as possible following play on Wednesday night.

CLUB THROWING AND OTHER UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR

The throwing of any club or any other unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated during the league season. This behavior is not only dangerous to yourself and those around you, but it also takes away from the enjoyment others may be experiencing during their round. Violent and/or unsportsmanlike outbursts will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the Director of Golf. If warnings (two or more) are deemed to be excessive, the violating player will be invited not to return to league competition for the remainder of the season – without refund.

ABSENCES – THE "THREE STRIKE" RULE

Each player will be allowed to miss a maximum of three league weeks with no penalty. If a player violates this rule, the teammate will have three options: 1.) the teammate will have the option to replace the violating player (replacement must have a valid GHIN account); 2.) the teammate may allow the violating player to remain on the team; or 3.) the Director of Golf may invite the offending player to withdraw from competition without refund. Players who violate the "three strike" rule may not be allowed to participate in league during the following season. To gain access to league in 2026, the offending player must re-apply with the Director of Golf although this is not guarantee he will be allowed to return. Breakfast Hill Golf Club will strictly enforce this rule on behalf of the effected team(s). All contact information for club officials is located on PAGE 1 of this document.
